2 rounds, the second round will include a Task, which will be on Course Plan.

Seniors: All of the above classes are open to senior riders. Seniors riders will be scored and awarded ribbons separately, according to their placing in that class and points awarded accordingly to determine the overall Senior Award from all eligible classes; for Showjumping & Jumping Equitation must compete in Official classes. If height not stated seniors will be placed in 80cm.

Helpers: All Clubs are asked to help out on the day of the competition. In particular, to ensure the smooth running of the day, we will be asking for helpers to help adjust the courses and pick up rails during the day. We may also need to call for pencilers on the day. If everyone helps a bit it will make for a well-run day for our competitors.

PCAQ rules Apply to all events

PCAQ Rider ID / Membership Card: From January 2006 PCAQ require that all riders produce their "PCAQ Rider ID card" on the day. (This is in addition to grading cards where applicable to the class entered) This ID number must be included on the event nomination form.

Two Horses: Riders may enter one competitive horse in Official Programme and one competitive horse in the Height Classes OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC and must be nominated as such on the entry form. Riders in competing in the graded classes cannot ride another graded horse in unofficial classes under 80cm.
